





Please give thanks for the life of Alfred Herb Hill (known as Herb) who died in Brisbane on 23/7/2023. Herb and wife Eva have been long time members of the St James Cathedral Parish. Due to poor health and advanced aged they recently moved to Brisbane to be closer to family.

The funeral will be held at the Centenary Memorial Gardens cemetery and crematorium on Friday 4 August, at 3:30pm. It will be live streamed. Details to follow

GARDEN SEAT

Given in memory of HERBERT WILLIAM CURTIS 1866–1909 by Herb (Grandson) and Eva Hill.

Herbert was curate at the Cathedral 1893-97, being ordained priest in 1894.

For a short time in 1897 he was the incumbent at Herberton, then he went as rector to St. Margaret's Croydon as Rector of 1898-1901.




Herbert was born in Warminster, England, he was a keen athlete and a prominent football player obtaining some note as an international player. He received training for the ministry at St. Boniface's Theological College, Warminster in 1888 1890 -arrived in Australia 1891 -ordained Deacon in the Diocese of 1891-92- curate of Kaniva (Vic). Ballarat 1893-07 -curate at St James' Cathedral 1894 – ordained priest 1897 incumbent at Herberton. 1898-1901 Rector of St. Margaret's Parish Croydon.

Sonejace Collège barminster was ordained Del 61! Priest on the x61? day of Delibur 1894 by the hord Bishop of the Diocese at an Ordination hald in Saint James Cathedral, Downsville.

Jebent William Centio was duly

1898. liceioed as Pichi of Samil Margaret Parish

During his time in Croydon, the Church of England in North Queensland was facing major reorganization. The Diocese of North Queensland was too large for efficient administration under the conditions of the time, and a decision was made to excise its northern parts into a new Diocese to be known as Carpentaria. Gilbert WHITE was enthroned as first Bishop of the new diocese, with Rev. Curtis being present at the enthronement on 18 November 1900. Herbert took up his appointment as Rector of Christ Church, Cooktown and it seems, he became the Bishop's right hand man.

He then moved to NSW and continued his ministry in Cobargo, Albury and Wagga Wagga




Emergency Medical Information Book

Now that you have your Emergency Medical Information Book, take some time to record your personal and medical information so that it is ready for use in an emergency. To retain the accuracy, have the information checked with the help of your local Doctor, Carer, an Ambulance Officer or a close relative.

Please take your book with you, each time you visit a Doctor or any Clinic.

Two Basic Things to Remember:

- please print clearly
- keep information in the book up to date

Patient Information

This section is straightforward. Fill in all the information you can in the spaces provided. Your UR number (Medical Record) can be added if you go to hospital or copied from your outpatient book.

Patient Medications

This section records all the medication you are currently taking. Record the date that you started the medication (give an approximate date if you have been taking the medication for a long time), its name, the dose, and what time of the day you take it, in the space provided. Example:



August 29th 1959.

HRH Princess Alexandra of Kent visited the Cathedral during construction and presented a Cross of Nails to be set into the stone.

The Cross is made of medieval nails collected from the bombed ruins of St Michael's Cathedral in Coventry. Similar nails have been sent to a number of churches throughout the world.





This Foundation Stone is for the completion of the final stage.

The stone was blessed by the Bishop of Coventry on August 20th 1959



The stone was set by the Primate of Australia on June 12th 1960
