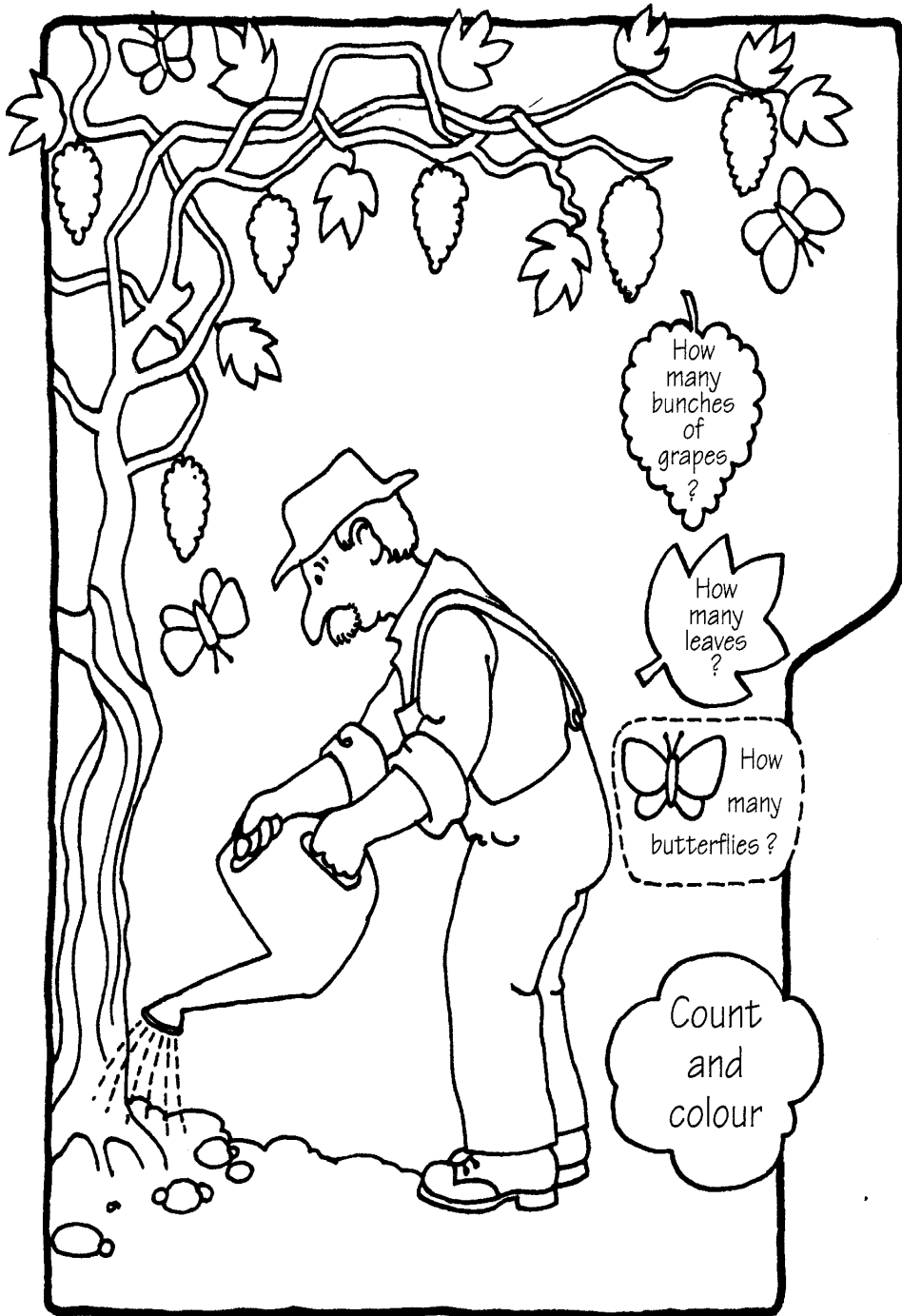

Dear Father, help us remember that we need to stay plugged into Jesus if we are going to produce the kind of good fruit you want from us. **Amen.**

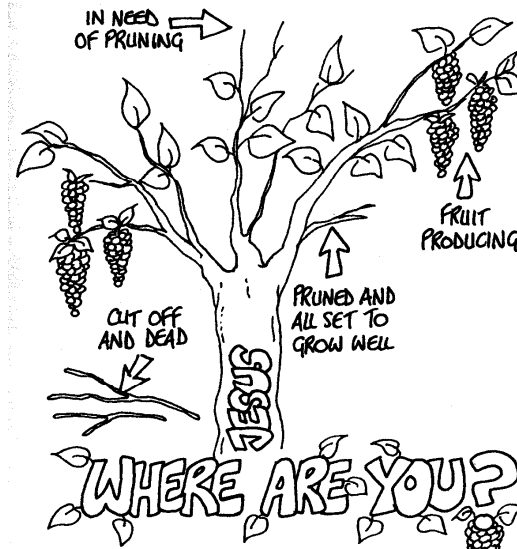
